Re: Year 9 Options

The curriculum students' study in Key Stage 4 is of utmost importance. We have developed an Ebacc driven curriculum which ensures that our students will not be held back by the subjects they study at GCSE. This ties into the Department of Education directive that schools are to have the Ebacc at the heart of their curriculum by 2025.

Research has proven that studying subjects included in the Ebacc provides students with greater opportunities in further education and increases the likelihood that a student will stay on in full time education. Studying the Ebacc can also improve a student's performance in English and Mathematics.

To achieve the Ebacc, students must study at least seven GCSEs in these five areas: English Language, English Literature, Mathematics, Combined Science or Triple Science, History or Geography and a Modern Foreign Language.

The study of a Modern Foreign Language is extremely beneficial because it will give our students a competitive edge. It will provide an insight into other cultures and can open the door to travel and employment opportunities. The study of a language also broadens students' horizons, helping them flourish in new environments.
