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Dear Parent/Carers

As you will be aware, the grades that pupils achieve at GCSE will determine their Post 16 options, university or apprenticeship choices, careers and future salary. Therefore, it is pivotal that all pupils are given the opportunities to succeed.

As we enter the final half-term of the academic year, I wanted to share some important updates regarding your child's future and the support that will be put in place over the coming months, to help prepare them for their GCSEs in the summer of 2024.

Mock Exams

The Year 10 mock exams are scheduled to begin on Tuesday 20th June 2023. This will be the first time many pupils will have sat a formal examination in form settings. Therefore, it is vital all pupils and parents/carers have read the attached JCQ regulations, which we will be following as a school.

Once these mock exams have been completed teachers will mark these papers, pupils can expect to receive their results during a results afternoon on Wednesday 19th July 2023.

Topic Lists

All Year 10 pupils have received topic lists for the below examinations two weeks ago. Please ask your child about this topic list; it was produced for them to help support them with their mock exam preparations.

Tutor Time Intervention (8.30am – 9.10am)

From Monday 19th June 2023 we will split Year 10 pupils into smaller tutor groups to help created some specific intervention groups across English, mathematics, science, history and French. Pupils will be supported by subject specialists, covering further exam content and exam techniques, as well as covering key revision concepts to help students prepare for their mock examinations and moving forward into Year 11. Therefore, it is vital all pupils are in school on time to ensure they can all fully engage in this process.

Introduction of Period 6

From Monday 19th June 2023 we will begin our first Period 6 intervention programme with staff putting additional sessions on for pupils (3.00pm – 4.00pm). These sessions are an expectation, we expect all pupils to attend all sessions that are put on for them. Different pupils will be required for different days after school.
