# Support for Year 11

I wish to update you with some important forthcoming dates for Year 11.

# **Final Exams**

These commenced on Monday 15th May, 2023 and run until Friday 23rd June, 2023.

All pupils have received their personalised timetables for the official exam period. There is also the master timetable here: <u>Summer-Exams-Timetable-2023.pdf (wednesfieldacademy.com)</u>

Please check the timetable carefully before booking any summer holidays. Exam results will be available from 9 am on Thursday 24th August, 2023. If you know that you will not be able to collect the results on this day, please email postbox@wednesfieldacademy.co.uk to make alternative collection arrangements.

To support pupils with their preparation for the exam period, we have put the following support in place:

## 1. 'Drop Down' Timetable

Pupils will not have study leave and are expected to remain in attendance until their last exam.

Pupils will now follow a personalised timetable to give then intensive 'drop down' time in the hours leading up to the exam.

Copies will be issued to pupils each week in assembly and the full version can be found on the website.

## 2. Period 6

Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday 3.00 pm – 4.00 pm.

Period 6 sessions will be on offer for the following day's exams – the timetable for these can be seen on the 'drop down' timetable.

These sessions are now optional to allow pupils access to directed revision with a subject specialist.





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### 3. Revision Breakfasts

Monday to Friday – 8.00 am to 8.30 am.

The 'drop down' timetable also includes morning revision sessions with subject staff.

These will start from 8 am (some earlier) and pupils will be provided breakfast from 8 am to include, a pastry and fruit juice, to set them up for their exam. Student must ensure they have their mark by 8.35 am from their form tutor.

### 4. Quiet Revision

In the Library everyday 3.00 pm - 5.30 pm, for those who do not have a revision class on a particular day. It is expected that pupils are able to use the library for quiet study under supervision.

Pupils do not need to book into this session and can leave when they choose but must inform the staff member on duty. It is expected that pupils use this to focus on study. Any pupil who misuses this facility will be directed to leave.
