Re: National Education Union Teachers' Strike on Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> July 2023 and Friday 7<sup>th</sup> July 2023.

We wish to inform you that a proportion of our teaching staff belong to the National Education Union, therefore we will not be able to operate the academy as we would normally do on the two days of strike action over next week.
