## Key Stage 4 FFT Grades - FFT Baselines - what do they mean?

Your child has a baseline grade for each of their subjects, which we expect them to achieve or exceed in their GCSE results. Year 11 pupils have been made aware of what these grades are and they appear on the reports sent home. The Fischer Family Trust (FFT) processes the National Pupil Database for the Department of Education and provides data and analyses to all schools in England and Wales. They provide grade predictors for pupil attainment at the end of Key Stage 4 and Wednesfield Academy use these to inform the setting of ambitious and aspirational targets for pupils.

FFT is based on KS2 scores - the non-for-profit organisation look at the GCSE scores of all the pupils who got the same scores as your child when they were in Year 6 and then use that to work out the probability of your child getting particular grades at GCSE. These datasets are updated each year.

FFT benchmarks are based on how similar pupils nationally performed in the subject last year (similar pupils are defined as similar prior attainment, gender and month of birth). It is important for all pupils to remember their baselines are not the ceiling on what they can achieve, and many will hopefully surpass their baseline.
