Dear Parent/Carer

This letter is to inform you of some important updates and I would also like to take this opportunity to thank parents/carers for their ongoing support.

# **Planners**

As you will be aware, all pupils have been given a school planner. This will enable all pupils to record homework and for parents/carers to write messages in for their child's Form Tutor to see. Please can you sign the planner each week, as this way the Form Tutor will know that you have seen any stickers or notes from staff, as well as viewed your child's homework. It is vital that your child brings in a bag each day to keep the planner and their books in. Every pupil needs to keep their planner in good condition and if they lose their planner they will need to purchase a replacement.

# Support Services

Wednesfield Academy are proud to have a Mental Health Practitioner and School Counsellor who work with our pupils for a variety of reasons. If you feel your child would benefit from accessing these support services please let their Head of House know, who will be able to put this support in place. ## Period 6 - Year 11 and 13

Year 11 and 13 pupils have already shown excellent attendance to their first few period 6 sessions. All of year 11 will be given a card which the teacher will sign to show their attendance, so you as parents can also closely monitor this. If your child is not doing a period 6 session in a subject that you feel they need extra support in, then please contact Mr Hill (Assistant Headteacher) by calling or emailing the school.

## **Classcharts**

All parents (including Sixth Form) have a classcharts account for their child. On this app are all the behaviour and praise points, as well as their attendance. If you do not have access to this account, then please email the school postbox address and we will get this set-up for you.

# Praise and Behaviour Points

Pupils can earn praise points and receive behaviour points throughout their school day. The accumulation of these can be seen via the Classcharts app and are monitored in school by Heads of House and Leadership. Should pupils receive behaviour points, appropriate sanctions will be issued. We prefer to celebrate with our pupils, therefore, there is a substantial rewards system being introduced this academic year. Through the accumulation of praise points, pupils can receive a range of rewards on a weekly, and termly basis. These rewards include free items from the school kitchen, vouchers, group experiences and trips. This system will be explained to pupils in the upcoming assemblies.

## Sparx Maths

The mathematics department are delighted to let you know that pupils will be completing their maths homework with Sparx Maths this academic year. Sparx is an exciting online platform that offers every pupil a personalised maths homework. We know that you want to support your child's maths progress so we have put together this letter to explain how Sparx works and why it is important to make sure that maths homework is 100% completed.

#### How does Sparx homework work?

Sparx personalises each child's homework, creating a weekly set of questions tailored to their level of understanding and learning pace. The questions are designed to be achievable whilst offering the stretch that learners need to make progress. Each week, topics are set by your child's maths teacher and will make up the majority of the homework questions. Questions from previous topics will also be included in the homework so that pupils can keep practising the skills they have learned.

#### How can I help my child with their homework?

We appreciate that you will of course want to support your child with their home learning which is fantastic and what we want. However, please try not to help them with a question until they have had a go first. It is really important that they complete their homework independently, and that questions are marked as correct. They can watch the support video if they need to. This way, Sparx can make sure your child continues to see homework that is at the right level for them.

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# Why does my child need to achieve 100% compulsory homework completion?

Sparx Homework is deliberately designed to help pupils really get to grips with and understand the concepts and skills they are learning by ensuring they cover the essential building blocks needed to make progress in maths. Sparx' research (www.sparx.co.uk/evidence) has shown that an average of 60 minutes a week of this type of personalised maths home learning leads to clear progress. It is therefore advised that pupils do their homework as early as possible, so they have the time to have a go themselves and seek help from their teacher if needed. Homework is not marked as complete until all of the compulsory questions have been answered correctly, so starting early is key to finishing before the homework deadline. Pupils will be shown how to log in during their Maths lessons. Pupils need to initially set up their account by typing in Sparx Maths on Google and then entering the following:

### School: Wednesfield Username: First Name and Last Name

Any login details can be reset by your child's Maths Teacher. You can keep track of your child's homework completion in the weekly email you will receive from Sparx. We hope you agree that Sparx will play an exciting and important role in helping your child's understanding, success and confidence in maths to grow.
