

## French Curriculum Overview

**Curriculum Intent:** Learning a foreign language is core to our whole school intent to develop well-rounded global citizens. Studying a language allows pupils to deepen their understanding of the world around them, including developing knowledge of target language culture and traditions. Our curriculum enables pupils to express themselves accurately and to communicate effectively in French, including listening and responding to others. We want our pupils to be curious about how language develops and changes, and how to manipulate language to suit their own communication goals.

**Curriculum Rationale:** Progression in French is based around building more complex language, using a range of tenses and other grammatical structures to communicate effectively. Pupils build their confidence in decoding unfamiliar language as they become familiar with the links between sound and spelling, and increasingly able to communicate in a variety of different contexts. Our curriculum focuses on mastering key grammatical concepts and transferring this knowledge through many different topics to deepen their understanding of how language fits together.
