## JCQ Examination Regulations

The mock examinations are conducted under the JCQ Examination Regulations. To support your child to be familiar with and understand these regulations, please below the link to the JCQ information for Candidates Written Examinations 2023-23.

It is essential that pupils do read these and adhere to them during the mock examinations. Breach of these regulations during an externally set examination can lead to disqualification for the pupil.

The following items are banned from examinations: mobile phones, all watches including smart watches and tablets. Pupils will be reported to the examination board if they have any of these items with them and this is likely to lead to disqualification. It may be worth pupils leaving their watches at home on the days of mock examinations. Additionally, it may be pertinent for sixth formers if they bring their phones into school to leave their mobile with a trusted friend during the times of examinations.

Pupils will need to bring the following equipment into mock examinations:

- Black Ball Point Pen x2
- Pencil
- Ruler
- Rubber
- Calculator, where required
- Protractor, where required
- Compass, where required

If pupils wish to store these in a pencil case, it must be a transparent pencil case containing no writing.

Pupils are allowed to bring a bottle of water into the examination, but this must be in a clear bottle with any labels removed.
