#### Dear Parent/Carer

#### **Festive Market**

We would like to thank all parents, pupils, staff and members of the community who made this evening possible. Last Thursday evening the school had a fantastic attendance at our annual Festive Market, with more stalls and attendees than the previous year. This would not have been possible without the Wednesfield Friends parents' group which we are so lucky to have at the school. We are looking forward to further events next term and will be keeping you updated.

#### Lockdown

The pupils conducted themselves in an exemplary manner during the school's first lockdown drill, and their excellent conduct was noted by multiple staff. Although the eventuality of an unwanted intruder is highly unlikely, especially with the new buzzer and fencing at the front of the school, it is still something we unfortunately must be prepared for in order to keep all pupils, staff and visitors safe. We will be doing one further trial lockdown before the end of the term to ensure the small refinements we have made after feedback from the first drill are acted on. Although we always want to inform pupils and parents in advance, we will not be able to inform the pupils of which day this will be on, as we must ensure the school can go into lockdown to immediately without notice.

## Thursday 21st December 2023 (last day of Autumn term)/Monday 8th January 2024 (first day of Spring term)

As outlined in previous correspondence, the last day of this term (Thursday 21st December) will be a 12.40pm finish for all pupils. Pupils will be registered by their form tutor before departing for a well-deserved break. The first day back on Monday 8th January 2024 is normal timings for all pupils, and they are expected on school site by 8.25am. The school phone lines and postbox will shut at 2.00pm on Friday 22nd December, so any voicemails and emails will be responded to when we return in January. Most importantly, please be aware that all pupils can wear Christmas jumpers over their school uniform on the last two days of this term (20.12.23/21.12.23).

## **Turing Trips**

All pupils selected for the funded trips to Sweden, Italy and Peru have now been informed of the exciting oversees opportunity. As outlined in previous letters from the trust, all pupils' attendance, behaviour and attitude to learning must be of the highest standard in order to attend.
