Appointments can be made on the Matrix Academy Trust/WeDuc app from 9.00am on Wednesday 7th February 2024 and will close at 1.00pm on Wednesday 21st February 2024. Please note that video appointments are strictly limited to five minutes, a timer at the foot of the screen indicates the length of time remaining in the meeting and after five minutes the video link will close. Your child's teacher has no control over this. If you have any remaining questions following your appointment, please contact your child's House Office. Following the helpful feedback from Parents Evenings where parents have explained it has been difficult to attend in person due to child care and returning from work, we hope that by completing the appointments online it will make it easier for parents to attend.
