## Year 9 Options

The curriculum pupils' study in Key Stage 4 is of utmost importance. We have developed an Ebacc driven curriculum, which ensures that our pupils will not be held back by the subjects they study at GCSE. This ties into the Department of Education directive that schools are to have the Ebacc at the heart of their curriculum by 2025.

Research has proven that studying subjects included in the Ebacc provides pupils with greater opportunities in further education and increases the likelihood that a pupil will stay on in full time education. Studying the Ebacc can also improve a pupil's performance in English and mathematics.

To achieve the Ebacc, pupils must study at least 7 GCSEs in these five areas: English language, English literature, mathematics, combined science or triple science, history or geography and a modern foreign language.

The study of a modern foreign language is extremely beneficial because it will give our pupils a competitive edge. It will provide an insight into other cultures and can open the door to travel and employment opportunities. The study of a language also broadens pupils' horizons, helping them flourish in new environments.

In the week commencing 4<sup>th</sup> March 2024, your child will receive an introductory assembly about the Year 10 Ebacc Pathway and receive presentations from each Head of Faculty to outline the course content and assessment methods for each subject. The week commencing 11<sup>th</sup> March 2024, pupils will be sent a link to an online form where they will make their choice between history or geography and their choice of one additional subject. Pupils will be expected to indicate their 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> choice of additional subject. Whilst we endeavour to provide pupils with their first choice, we cannot guarantee that this will always be possible.
