Dear Parent/Carer

Thank you for supporting your child with their upcoming GCSE examinations. This letter provides some vital updates for the final preparation stages. English and Maths Groups

Your child may have been placed in a different English and/or Maths group for this term. These changes have been made to enable targeted intervention based on the areas of improvement from their recent mock examinations. This is to subsequently improve the grade pupils received this August.

English and Maths Masterclasses

Some Year 11 pupils will have a slightly adapted timetable so that they can receive extra English and/or Maths sessions. If this applies to your child it is because they have been identified as a pupil who would benefit from this extra support in order to secure the best grade possible in their core subjects. As we work closely with a range of post-16 providers, we recognise the importance of these core subjects in order to enable their progression regardless of the chosen route at post-16. These additional sessions will be delivered by Mrs Hambrook and Mrs Smith, who are specialist teachers from the trust who have experience in focused GCSE revision. These groups are around eight to ten pupils, so will therefore be targeted to the precise needs of the class.

There will also be sessions delivered by Miss Kapoor (National Tutoring Programme mentor) who has worked with a number of pupils across the school. The sessions with Miss Kapoor will contain between three to five pupils, so will also be concentrated to the specific needs of the group.

Timetables During Examinations

Once examinations start, pupils will begin to have finished work in certain subjects e.g. if a pupil has completed all the work needed for BTEC Sport and there are no further examinations to be taken in that subject. When this happens, pupils will either be revising during this lesson with the revision material provided, or they will be placed in extra lessons for the subjects they are still to complete. It is essential that pupils continue to work with maximum effort in all lesson time, as it will have an impact on their final grades.

Breakfast Club and Study Hall

From Monday 8th April 2024 there will be breakfast club before school every day from 8.00am until 8.30am. This will take place in the library and tea, drinks and toast will be provided for the pupils to revise and work quietly.
