Pupil premium strategy outcomes

This details the impact that our pupil premium activity had on pupils in the 2022 to 2023 academic year.

There has been some increase in A8 score for PP pupils compared to 21/22 cohort. Gaps compared to N-PP remain across all measures although the gap has reduced in terms of the A8 and Basics 5+ measures.

Exclusions

Our target was for pupil premium pupils to receive less than 120 exclusions.

This remains a focus for improvement as the number of exclusions last year was higher than the target with PP exclusions proportionally higher than non-PP pupils with 57.5% of exclusions allocated to disadvantaged pupils.
