Re: Year 9 Pathways

The curriculum pupils study in Key Stage 4 is of utmost importance. We have developed an EBacc driven curriculum which ensures that our pupils will not be held back by the subjects they study at GCSE.

Research has proven that studying subjects included in the EBacc provides pupils with greater opportunities in further education and increases the likelihood that a pupil will stay on in full time education. Studying the EBacc can also improve a pupil's performance in English and Mathematics.

To achieve the EBacc, pupils must study at least seven GCSEs in these five areas: English Language, English Literature, Mathematics, Combined Science or Triple Science, History or Geography and a Modern Foreign Language (MFL).

The study of a modern foreign language is extremely beneficial because it will give our pupils a competitive edge. It will provide an insight into other cultures and can open the door to travel and employment opportunities. The study of a language also broadens pupils' horizons, helping them flourish in new environments.

- their choice between French, Geography or History
- their choice of two additional subjects. Pupils will be expected to indicate their 1st, 2nd,3rd and 4th choice of additional subjects and whilst we endeavour to provide pupils with their choices, we cannot guarantee that this will always be possible.

We require all pupils to complete the online form by Friday 28th March 2025.

Please note that some subjects will not be able to run should the number of pupils who choose this be too low.
