# **Year 13 Autumn Mock Exams**

As you will be aware, the grades that students achieve at A-Level will determine their options after Sixth Form, whether by university or apprenticeship choices, careers and future salary. Therefore, it is pivotal that all students are given the opportunities to succeed.

This letter outlines important details about your child's mock exams that will begin in a few weeks' time.

## **Mock Exams**

The Year 13 mock exams are scheduled to begin on Monday 13<sup>th</sup> October 2025.

There will be no re-sit/catch up exams during this mock period (just like in the formal exams this summer). If your child misses an exam due to absence or punctuality, they will get a U grade, which will impact on their final mock grade and predicted grades from their teachers. It is therefore imperative that your child sits all their mock papers.

It is vital all students and parents/carers have read the attached JCQ regulations, which we will be following as a school. Once these mock exams have been completed teachers will mark these papers, students can expect to receive their results during a results assembly on Monday 24<sup>th</sup> November 2025.
