# Period 6 Update

We would like to thank Year 11 for their continued hard work and excellent attendance at Period 6; we are currently in Phase 2 of the Period 6 programme which will finish on Thursday 27th November 2025.

Phase 3 Period 6 will start on Monday 1st December 2025, and letters detailing which subjects pupils will be attending will be released on week commencing 24th November 2025.

## Home Learning Update

As we review our Home Learning Policy, we can confirm that all home learning sanctions will now take place in the same location as any other sanctions. Home Learning Club remains available for pupils to voluntarily attend before their home learning deadline but will no longer be for pupils who fail to complete their home learning.

# Personal Statements and Tutor References

This week in Personal Development time we have launched with pupils', personal statements, pupils will be writing these over the next three weeks in Personal Development Form time. Year 11 form tutors will also be completing their references for pupils. Pupils will receive all this information (if they complete it) in a pack week commencing 15th December 2025 ready for them to use in their Sixth Form/college/apprenticeship applications.

# **Coursework Deadlines**

Several of our coursework deadlines are now approaching. If your child is doing coursework, it is imperative that they meet these deadlines with work that is to the required standard to ensure pupils meet their true potential.

As AI technology becomes increasingly accessible, many online platforms can now generate essays, solve problems, or produce written and creative work. While these tools may seem helpful, their use in assessed coursework undermines the purpose of independent learning and assessment.

It is essential that all coursework represents each pupil's own understanding, effort, and ability. For this reason, pupils are not permitted to use AI tools (such as ChatGPT, Google Gemini, or similar programs) in the creation or completion of any coursework, assignments, or controlled assessments that contribute to their final grades.

Any work found to have been produced or significantly assisted by AI will be treated as plagiarism or malpractice and will be subject to the same sanctions outlined in our academic Integrity Policy. Teachers and examination boards are increasingly able to identify Al-generated material, and we are committed to maintaining fairness and honesty in all academic work.

Pupils are, of course, encouraged to use technology responsibly for research and revision under teacher guidance. However, all written responses, analysis, and conclusions must be entirely their own.

We would appreciate your support in reinforcing this message at home. Upholding academic honesty ensures that every pupil's achievement truly reflect their hard work and understanding.

It is important that applications to colleges are completed within the next couple of months to secure conditional places. Certain courses at colleges get full very quickly and it is never too early to apply.


In terms of apprenticeships, these also need to be applied for as soon as possible - the application process is just as rigorous as any other pathway and is a popular choice at post-16.
