- o Indoor shoes (slippers, crocs, clean trainers)
- Towel
- o 2 pairs of shorts suitable to wear over a wetsuit
- Lunch box preferable rigid plastic (chiller bags get squashed easily)
- Any medication you take such as an inhaler, <u>it is vital the child's name and form are on it.</u>

- Slippers
- Pocket money (no more than £20)
- Snacks
