Duke of Edinburgh Bronze Award Expedition Dates 2026

I am delighted to share with your child the dates for the practise expedition at Sutton Park and assessed expedition at Cannock Chase to complete the Wednesfield Academy Bronze Duke of Edinburgh Award 2026 expedition section. Prior to completing these, attendance to after school sessions will be continued monitored to ensure pupils are fully trained for their assessed expedition. Additionally, pupils must have completed a minimum of two sections prior to their assessed expedition, either from their volunteering, skills or physical section which is continuously monitored.

The dates for the Practise Expedition and the Assessed Expedition are as followed:

The practise expedition will take place at Sutton Park, a large urban park in Sutton Coldfield, Birmingham. The purpose of this for the Bronze DofE Award is to ensure pupils apply skills and knowledge learned from their after-school training sessions into a practical setting using navigational skills and physical training through walking prior to their assessed expedition.

The assessed expedition will start from Cannock Chase and will finish at Lichfield Cathedral where pupils must use navigational skills, teamwork and their physical ability to complete the recommended number of hours of planned activity, which is 6 hours. Pupils will camp overnight at the Beaudesert Campsite in Cannock Chase.

As stated previously, pupils will be provided with tents, maps which will have their planned route on, as well as cooking equipment. Pupils will be provided a recommended kit list prior to the expedition where they will be required to have walking boots, sleeping bag and roll mat, a large 65L rucksack, expedition clothing and food. If you are unable to purchase an item of appropriate clothing, walking boots, sleeping bag or an appropriately sized rucksack, please inform Mr Dunn (DofE Lead), as we do have a limited amount of spare kit, which can be lent to the pupils under certain circumstances. This must be discussed with Mr Dunn prior to the expedition.

Please complete the attached consent form and return to reception by Friday 30th January 2026. In the unlikely event that a child's behaviour does not match expectations, or they are not following the Duke of Edinburgh Award guidelines, then parents/carers will need to collect their child.
