Year 11 Mock Examinations

I would also like to congratulate our Year 11 pupils for their hard work throughout this mock examination series. Their conduct has been impeccable, and we are very proud of the maturity and dedication they have shown.

Staff will now be analysing the results in detail, including question-level analysis, so that we can provide targeted support as we move towards the summer examinations. It is important that pupils continue this positive momentum by following clear revision plans.

School Social Media

Following recent changes to the platform X (formerly Twitter), the Wednesfield Academy has reviewed its use of social media and has decided that it will no longer operate X as an official communication platform. Going forward, school updates and news will be shared via Facebook and Instagram, which are the platforms most widely used by our parents and school community. A final post will be made on X directing followers to these channels.

Parking Around School – Message from Wolverhampton City Council

We have been asked by the City of Wolverhampton Council Parking Enforcement Team to remind parents and carers about parking restrictions around the school site during drop-off and pick-up times.

The Wolverhampton Local Authority have said there continue to be significant issues with vehicles parking in restricted areas around the city. These restrictions are in place to ensure the safety of pupils, parents, and carers.

As a result, Civil Enforcement Officers from the Local Authority will now be issuing Penalty Charge Notices (PCNs) immediately to vehicles parked in contravention of restrictions near schools, without first asking drivers to move. If a driver leaves once the issuing process has begun, the PCN will be sent by post to the registered keeper.

A reminder that on Thursday 12th March 2026, the school will close to all pupils at 12.40pm to allow staff to complete moderation of GCSE and A-Level mock examination papers. Pupils who are eligible for Free School Meals will be able to collect food from the canteen before leaving the site.
