Year 11 Update Letter

Information Evening – Thursday 26th March (Arrival between 4.40pm and 5.10pm – finish at 6.00pm)

We are pleased to invite all Year 11 pupils and their parents/carers to attend a Year 11 Information Evening on Thursday 26th March 2026. This event will provide important information about the final stages of our pupil's GCSE journey and the support available in the lead-up to the formal examinations.

Parents/carers and pupils are welcome to arrive from 4.40pm, when pupils' mock results will be available to collect on entry. At 5.10pm there will be a short presentation delivered by myself, Ms Ball (Deputy Headteacher) and Mr Hill (Assistant Headteacher) outlining the key steps and expectations for Year 11 as pupils approach their GCSE examinations. The evening will conclude at approximately 6.00pm.

For those unable to attend, mock results will be distributed to pupils in school the following day, but we strongly advise all attend.

Period 6 – Phase 4

Period 6 sessions have now resumed and will continue until Friday 27th March. Please ensure that your child is aware of the sessions they are expected to attend. During this period there will be a reduced number of sessions available while staff complete the marking of mock examination papers to ensure the pupils receive the most effective feedback.

Easter Revision Sessions

The school will open during the Easter holidays to provide additional revision sessions. Pupils will be invited to attend specific subject sessions where teachers feel further support would be beneficial.

Please note that the school will be closed to both staff and pupils on the bank holidays (Friday 3rd April and Monday 6th April).

In addition, we will be offering a Study Hall on selected days during the holiday period. This will provide a quiet, supervised environment where pupils can revise independently in a silent space and focus on their own work. Similar sessions will also be available during the May half-term break.

Further details regarding the Easter revision programme and Study Hall sessions will be shared next week by Mr Hill.
