### Re: Year 11 - The Final Countdown

Thank you for all the support you have given your child in the build up to their GCSE examinations. #### Period 6 and Study Hall

From Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> May 2026 the library will be open to Year 11 pupils only for Study Hall each day after school from 3.00–4.00pm until the end of their examinations. This will be a place for the pupils to come and revise silently and independently; the school will provide refreshments and small snacks for pupils as recognition for their dedication and hard work. There will be lots of revision resources for them to access in the library.

This means that from Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> May 2026 pupils will only need to attend Period 6 sessions on the day **before** they have an examination.

It is therefore more crucial than ever that your child is on time to the school to receive this vital information every morning. It is always better for them to be in school revising, as lessons are still happening. Further to this, the school will apply all the normal attendance procedures if a pupil is not in school, including alerting the Local Authority to any persistently absent pupils.

As the examinations progress it is crucial pupils have revision work with them every day so if they are in a lesson or subject where they have finished, they may be provided time in this lesson to complete some self-study while having the teacher support them. To make the most effective use of this time pupils must ensure they have work from other subjects ready to use.

### **Year 11 Prom**

We are excited, and I am sure the pupils are, that Year 11 Prom will take place on Friday 26<sup>th</sup> June 2026 at Molineux Stadium starting at 6.30pm and finishing at 11.00pm.

As a reminder which has been communicated several times, to attend the Prom, pupils must have the below as well as being paid in full:

- Met all coursework and assessment deadlines across all subjects.
- Displayed excellent behaviour and conduct throughout all mock and real examinations.
- Shown their very best effort in their studies, aiming to reach their targets in all subjects.

To ensure there is complete clarity for all pupils, from the date of this letter, if there are any of the below your child's place at Prom will be removed as we want the evening to be a celebration of all your child's hard work and achievement:

- Any further missed days without medical evidence and your attendance is below 90%.
- Any further refused detentions, and this will result in suspension from this point forward at this stage in year 11 pupils are very clear on the rules there to support them.
- If a pupil has any further lates without a clear valid reason and they have multiple previous lates.
- Any time spent in the reflection room or if they are suspended.
- A number of negatives from this point forward.

As your child embarks on their exciting next steps, it is important that we have accurate records of their plans after Year 11, whether that is here at Wednesfield Academy or another college or Sixth Form.
