1. Check you have an exam timetable and are aware of when your exams are scheduled over the coming weeks.
2. Ensure you can log into your school email account, GCSE Pod and any other site you need access to for revision – any issues please speak to your PD tutor.
3. Create a weekly revision timetable and establish a consistent routine around revision and social activities.
4. Plan your revision in advance so you do not waste time.
5. Ensure your child has all the relevant revision resources from the English, Maths and Science bootcamps.

Period 6 – Phase 5

Period 6 sessions have now resumed and will continue until Friday 22nd May.

Please ensure that your child is aware of the sessions they are expected to attend. All pupils have Period 6 sessions Monday - Thursday.

During this period all Year 11 detentions will be moved to a Friday between 3pm - 5pm, as this is to protect Period 6 session for both teachers and pupils. Although we hope that no pupils will receive detentions during this period, if they did, they would sit all the detentions they receive then.

Please remind your child of the school's expectations to avoid this happening.

Dropdown Timetable

From w/c 4th May Year 11 pupils will have their timetables amended daily based upon what exams they on that day or week. It is crucial they arrive to school on time to gather this information from their personal tutor each morning.

May - Half Term Revision Sessions

The school will open during the May Half-Term holidays to provide additional revision sessions. Pupils will be invited to attend specific subject sessions where teachers feel further support would be beneficial. Please note that the school will be closed to both staff and pupils on the bank holiday (Monday 25th May).

In addition, we will be offering a Study Hall on selected days during the holiday period. This will provide a quiet, supervised environment where pupils can revise independently in a silent space and focus on their own work. Further details regarding the revision programme and Study Hall sessions will be shared in the coming week by Mr Hill (Assistant Headteacher).

Year 11 Prom

The Year 11 Prom will take place on Friday 26th June 2026 at the Molineux Stadium beginning at 6.30pm and concluding at 11.00pm.

To be eligible to attend the Prom pupils must have:

- Met all coursework and assessment deadlines across all subjects.
- Displayed exemplary behaviour and conduct throughout all mock and external GCSE examinations.
- Demonstrated an excellent attitude to learning in all their subjects, consistently striving to achieve the highest possible grades.

Please note that if a pupil is suspended or had not behaved to the standard we expect, this will place their opportunity to attend the prom at risk.
