Year 12 Already Doing It Careers-focused Session

We are pleased to inform you that Year 12 students at Wednesfield Academy will be taking part in an upcoming careers-focused session delivered by *Already Doing It*.

This workshop is designed to support students as they begin thinking seriously about their future pathways, particularly in relation to university and career decision-making.

About the Workshop

The session will include:

- Guidance to help Year 12 students make informed choices before deciding what to study at university.
- A personal insight from the founder of *Already Doing It*, including their journey as an optometrist and reflections on career decisions.
- Live contributions from current university students, who will join via a live link to answer students' questions honestly and openly around university life and the course they have chosen.

Funded Student Sessions

Following the workshop, a limited number of students will have access to **fully funded one-to-one sessions** with *Already Doing It* mentors. These sessions provide personalized guidance with a current university student and can be selected based on university and course with many different options available.

The sessions students choose to take part in will be:

- At home, with a parent/carer present, or
- At school, with a member of staff available on site

Students will need access to a quiet space, a device, and headphones. The supervising adult does not need to participate in the session itself.

Each funded session is accessed using a unique code, which will be shared with selected students after the workshop. All codes expire on **30th June 2026**.

In addition, all Sixth Form students will be able to access a **50% discount** on *Already Doing It* sessions using the code:


Next Steps
